



Present Perfect Continuous Tense **Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)**

1) We have not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

Pos: *Have we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?*

2) I have not been practicing yoga for the past month.

Pos: *Have I been practicing yoga for the past month?*

3) You have not been studying French all evening.

Pos: *Have you been studying French all evening?*

4) He has not been working on his novel since last year.

Pos: *Has he been working on his novel since last year?*

5) She has not been gardening for hours.

Pos: *Has she been gardening for hours?*

6) We have not been waiting for the train since morning.

Pos: *Have we been waiting for the train since morning?*

7) They have not been renovating their house for weeks.

Pos: *Have they been renovating their house for weeks?*

8) It has not been snowing continuously since yesterday.

Pos: *Has it been snowing continuously since yesterday?*

9) John has not been learning to play the guitar for months.

Pos: *Has John been learning to play the guitar for months?*

10) Sarah has not been attending dance classes regularly.

Pos: *Has Sarah been attending dance classes regularly?*
