Neg: They are not eating lunch together.

2) Is the dog wagging its tail?

Neg: The dog is not wagging its tail.

3) Are the children playing with toys?

Neg: The children are not playing with toys.

4) Are my friends coming over for dinner?

Neg: My friends are not coming over for dinner.

5) Are the workers repairing the road?

Neg: The workers are not repairing the road.

6) Are the stars shining brightly?

Neg: The stars are not shining brightly.

7) Am I taking a shower?

Neg: I am not taking a shower.

8) Are you playing the piano beautifully?

Neg: You are not playing the piano beautifully.

9) Is he studying medicine?

Neg: He is not studying medicine.

10) Is she driving to work?

Neg: She is not driving to work.
