Neq: The birds weren't flying in the sky.

Neg: The students weren't listening to the lecture.

8) The car was speeding.

Neg: The car wasn't speeding.

9) I was daydreaming.

Neg: I wasn't daydreaming.

10) The baby was laughing.

Neg: The baby wasn't laughing.
