

<u>Exercise -Present Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Pos: We have been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Que: Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?

2) They have not been studying for the exam all week.

Pos: They have been studying for the exam all week.

Que: Have they been studying for the exam all week?

3) It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Pos: It has been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Que: Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

4) John has not been working out at the gym every day.

Pos: John has been working out at the gym every day.

Que: Has John been working out at the gym every day?

5) Sarah has not been practicing her presentation all morning.

Pos: Sarah has been practicing her presentation all morning.

Que: Has Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?
