1) We have been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Neg: We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Que: Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?

2) They have been studying for the exam all week.

Neg: They have not been studying for the exam all week.

Que: Have they been studying for the exam all week?

3) It has been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Neg: It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Que: Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

4) John has been working out at the gym every day.

Neg: John has not been working out at the gym every day.

Que: Has John been working out at the gym every day?

5) Sarah has been practicing her presentation all morning.

Neg: Sarah has not been practicing her presentation all morning.

Que: Has Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?
