Que: Had it been raining since morning when we decided to go outside?

John had not been working out at the gym regularly before he got injured.

Pos: John had been working out at the gym regularly before he got injured.

Que: Had John been working out at the gym regularly before he got injured?

Sarah had not been practicing her presentation for days before the conference.

Pos: Sarah had been practicing her presentation for days before the conference.

Que: Had Sarah been practicing her presentation for days before the conference?

The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Que: Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?
