**6)** They had not lived in New York before they moved to California.

**Pos:** Had they lived in New York before they moved to California?

**7)** It had not rained before we went outside.

**Pos:** Had it rained before we went outside?

**8)** John had not won the game before he injured his knee.

**Pos:** Had John won the game before he injured his knee?

**9)** Sarah had not finished her project before the deadline.
