7) It had rained before we went outside.

Neg: It had not rained before we went outside.

8) John had won the game before he injured his knee.

Neg: John had not won the game before he injured his knee.

9) Sarah had finished her project before the deadline.

Neg: Sarah had not finished her project before the deadline.

10) The train had arrived before we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not arrived before we reached the station.
