

Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

Pos: Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

Neg: Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

2) Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Neg: The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

3) Had I been waiting for the bus since morning?

Pos: I had been waiting for the bus since morning.

Neg: I had not been waiting for the bus since morning.

4) Had you been working on the project for hours?

Pos: You had been working on the project for hours.

Neg: You had not been working on the project for hours.

5) Had he been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: He had been studying for the exam all night.

Neq: He had not been studying for the exam all night.
