**1)** Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

**Pos:** Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

---

**Neg:** Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

---

**2)** Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

**Pos:** The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

---

**Neg:** The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

---

**3)** Had I been waiting for the bus since morning?

**Pos:** I had been waiting for the bus since morning.

---

**Neg:** I had not been waiting for the bus since morning.

---

**4)** Had you been working on the project for hours?

**Pos:** You had been working on the project for hours.

---

**Neg:** You had not been working on the project for hours.

---

**5)** Had he been studying for the exam all night?

**Pos:** He had been studying for the exam all night.

---

**Neg:** He had not been studying for the exam all night.
