



Future Perfect Continuous Tense **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

1) John had been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

Neg: John had not been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

2) Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.

Neg: Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.

3) I had been studying English for three months.

Neg: I had not been studying English for three months.

4) You had been working on the project all day.

Neg: You had not been working on the project all day.

5) He had been playing the guitar for two hours.

Neg: He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.

6) She had been writing her novel since morning.

Neg: She had not been writing her novel since morning.

7) We had been waiting for the train for half an hour.

Neg: We had not been waiting for the train for half an hour.

8) They had been practicing their dance routine for weeks.

Neg: They had not been practicing their dance routine for weeks.

9) It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

10) John had been studying for the exam since morning.

Neg: John had not been studying for the exam since morning.
