26) Pos. We have been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Neg. We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Que. Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?

27) Pos. They have been studying for the exam all week.

Neg. They have not been studying for the exam all week.

Que. Have they been studying for the exam all week?

28) Pos. It has been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Neg. It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Que. Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

29) Pos. John has been working out at the gym every day.

Neg. John has not been working out at the gym every day.

Que. Has John been working out at the gym every day?

30) Pos. Sarah has been practicing her presentation all morning.

Neg. Sarah has not been practicing her presentation all morning.

Que. Has Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?
