**26)** **Pos.** Sarah had been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

**Neg.** Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

**Que.** Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

**27)** **Pos.** The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

**Neg.** The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

**Que.** Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

---

**28)** **Pos.** I had been waiting for the bus since morning.

**Neg.** I had not been waiting for the bus since morning.

**Que.** Had I been waiting for the bus since morning?

---

**29)** **Pos.** You had been working on the project for hours.

**Neg.** You had not been working on the project for hours.

**Que.** Had you been working on the project for hours?

---

**30)** **Pos.** He had been studying for the exam all night.

**Neg.** He had not been studying for the exam all night.

**Que.** Had he been studying for the exam all night?
