1) Have the children been playing in the park all afternoon?

Pos: The children have been playing in the park all afternoon.

Neg: The children have not been playing in the park all afternoon.

2) Have I been reading this book for the past few days?

Pos: I have been reading this book for the past few days.

Neg: I have not been reading this book for the past few days.

3) Have you been watching TV for hours?

Pos: You have been watching TV for hours.

Neg: You have not been watching TV for hours.

4) Has he been studying Spanish for months?

Pos: He has been studying Spanish for months.

Neg: He has not been studying Spanish for months.

5) Has she been working on her computer all day?

Pos: She has been working on her computer all day.

Neg: She has not been working on her computer all day.
