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**Que:** Had I been working on this project for the past week?

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**2)** You had been studying English for hours.

**Neg:** You had not been studying English for hours.

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**Que:** Had you been studying English for hours?

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**3)** He had been playing video games all day.

**Neg:** He had not been playing video games all day.

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**Que:** Had he been playing video games all day?

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**4)** She had been practicing yoga since morning.

**Neg:** She had not been practicing yoga since morning.

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**Que:** Had she been practicing yoga since morning?

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**5)** We had been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

**Neg:** We had not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

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**Que:** Had we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?

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
