

## Exercise -Past Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) I had been working on this project for the past week.

Neg: I had not been working on this project for the past week.

Que: Had I been working on this project for the past week?

2) You had been studying English for hours.

Neg: You had not been studying English for hours.

Que: Had you been studying English for hours?

3) He had been playing video games all day.

Neg: He had not been playing video games all day.

Que: Had he been playing video games all day?

4) She had been practicing yoga since morning.

Neg: She had not been practicing yoga since morning.

Que: Had she been practicing yoga since morning?

5) We had been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

Neg: We had not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

Que: Had we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?
