Neg: You had not already seen that movie before.

2) Had he visited Paris twice before?

Neg: He had not visited Paris twice before.

3) Had she cooked dinner for the family?

Neg: She had not cooked dinner for the family.

4) Had they finished their work before the deadline?

Neg: They had not finished their work before the deadline.

5) Had it rained heavily the whole day?

Neg: It had not rained heavily the whole day.

6) Had John read three books last month?

Neg: John had not read three books last month.

7) Had Sarah learned to play the piano?

Neg: Sarah had not learned to play the piano.

8) Had the team won the championship?

Neg: The team had not won the championship.

9) Had you already left when I called you?

Neg: You had not already left when I called you.

10) Had he visited that city before?

Neg: He had not visited that city before.
