

Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) Had she been baking a cake since noon?

Pos: She had been baking a cake since noon.

Neg: She had not been baking a cake since noon.

2) Had we been traveling for days before we reached our destination?

Pos: We had been traveling for days before we reached our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for days before we reached our destination.

3) Had it been raining heavily all week?

Pos: It had been raining heavily all week.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all week.

4) Had John been practicing the guitar for months before his performance?

Pos: John had been practicing the guitar for months before his performance.

Neg: John had not been practicing the guitar for months before his performance.

5) Had Sarah been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain?

Pos: Sarah had been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.

Neq: Sarah had not been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.
