**Neg:** She had not been baking a cake since noon.

**Neg:** We had not been traveling for days before we reached our destination.

**3)** Had it been raining heavily all week?

**Pos:** It had been raining heavily all week.

---

**Neg:** It had not been raining heavily all week.

---

**4)** Had John been practicing the guitar for months before his performance?

**Pos:** John had been practicing the guitar for months before his performance.

---

**Neg:** John had not been practicing the guitar for months before his performance.

---

**5)** Had Sarah been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain?

**Pos:** Sarah had been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.

---

**Neg:** Sarah had not been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.
