



Present Perfect Continuous Tense **Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)**

1) The students have not been preparing for the presentation.

Pos: *Have the students been preparing for the presentation?*

2) We have not been waiting for our food for a long time.

Pos: *Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?*

3) I have not been working on this project all week.

Pos: *Have I been working on this project all week?*

4) You have not been studying for the exam for hours.

Pos: *Have you been studying for the exam for hours?*

5) He has not been playing football since this morning.

Pos: *Has he been playing football since this morning?*

6) She has not been painting a picture all day.

Pos: *Has she been painting a picture all day?*

7) We have not been waiting in line for hours.

Pos: *Have we been waiting in line for hours?*

8) They have not been practicing their dance routine.

Pos: *Have they been practicing their dance routine?*

9) It has not been raining since yesterday.

Pos: *Has it been raining since yesterday?*

10) John has not been studying Spanish for months.

Pos: *Has John been studying Spanish for months?*
