2) The baby is not sleeping.

Pos: *Is the baby sleeping?*

3) My friends are not coming over.

Pos: *Are my friends coming over?*

4) The birds are not singing.

Pos: *Are the birds singing?*

5) We are not going on a trip.

Pos: *Are we going on a trip?*

6) You are not eating a sandwich.

Pos: *Are you eating a sandwich?*

7) They are not laughing loudly.

Pos: *Are they laughing loudly?*

8) It is not getting late.

Pos: *Is it getting late?*

9) The children are not playing.

Pos: *Are the children playing?*

10) She is not wearing a red dress.

Pos: *Is she wearing a red dress?*
