1) Had they attended the meeting?

Neg: They had not attended the meeting.

Que: Had they attended the meeting?

2) I had finished my homework before dinner.

Neg: I had not finished my homework before dinner.

Que: Had I finished my homework before dinner?

3) You had visited London last year.

Neg: You had not visited London last year.

Que: Had you visited London last year?

4) He had already left when I arrived.

Neg: He had not already left when I arrived.

Que: Had he already left when I arrived?

5) She had cooked dinner before the guests arrived.

Neg: She had not cooked dinner before the guests arrived.

Que: Had she cooked dinner before the guests arrived?
