



## Past Continuous Tense

### Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)

1) We weren't jogging in the park.

Pos: *Were we jogging in the park?*

---

2) The students weren't discussing the topic.

Pos: *Were the students discussing the topic?*

---

3) The cat wasn't chasing a mouse.

Pos: *Was the cat chasing a mouse?*

---

4) She wasn't writing a letter.

Pos: *Was she writing a letter?*

---

5) The rain wasn't stopping.

Pos: *Was the rain stopping?*

---

6) They weren't playing hide-and-seek.

Pos: *Were they playing hide-and-seek?*

---

7) I wasn't cooking dinner.

Pos: *Was I cooking dinner?*

---

8) I was not studying for my exam.

Pos: *Was I studying for my exam?*

---

9) You were not playing basketball.

Pos: *Were you playing basketball?*

---

10) He was not reading a book.

Pos: *Was he reading a book?*

---
