31) **Pos.** The children have been playing in the park all afternoon.

Neg. The children have not been playing in the park all afternoon.

Que. Have the children been playing in the park all afternoon?

32) **Pos.** I have been reading this book for the past few days.

Neg. I have not been reading this book for the past few days.

Que. Have I been reading this book for the past few days?

33) **Pos.** You have been watching TV for hours.

Neg. You have not been watching TV for hours.

Que. Have you been watching TV for hours?

34) **Pos.** He has been studying Spanish for months.

Neg. He has not been studying Spanish for months.

Que. Has he been studying Spanish for months?

35) **Pos.** She has been working on her computer all day.

Neg. She has not been working on her computer all day.

Que. Has she been working on her computer all day?
