33) Pos. It had been raining heavily all week.

Neg. It had not been raining heavily all week.

Que. Had it been raining heavily all week?

34) Pos. John had been practicing the guitar for months before his performance.

Neg. John had not been practicing the guitar for months before his performance.

Que. Had John been practicing the guitar for months before his performance?

35) Pos. Sarah had been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.

Neg. Sarah had not been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.

Que. Had Sarah been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain?
