1) We have been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Neg: We have not been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Que: Have we been traveling around Europe for weeks?

2) They have been talking on the phone for hours.

Neg: They have not been talking on the phone for hours.

Que: Have they been talking on the phone for hours?

3) It has been snowing since early morning.

Neg: It has not been snowing since early morning.

Que: Has it been snowing since early morning?

4) Mary has been playing tennis for years.

Neg: Mary has not been playing tennis for years.

Que: Has Mary been playing tennis for years?

5) The students have been studying English grammar lately.

Neg: The students have not been studying English grammar lately.

Que: Have the students been studying English grammar lately?
