

Exercise -Past Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) They had been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Neg: They had not been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Que: Had they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?

2) It had been raining since yesterday.

Neg: It had not been raining since yesterday.

Que: Had it been raining since yesterday?

3) John had been studying for the exam all week.

Neg: John had not been studying for the exam all week.

Que: Had John been studying for the exam all week?

4) Sarah had been working on her art project all day.

Neg: Sarah had not been working on her art project all day.

Que: Had Sarah been working on her art project all day?

5) The children had been playing outside for hours.

Neg: The children had not been playing outside for hours.

Que: Had the children been playing outside for hours?
