Pos: The construction workers had been building the house for months before it was completed.

Neg: The construction workers had not been building the house for months before it was completed.

2) Had I been working on the project all day long?

Pos: I had been working on the project all day long.

Neg: I had not been working on the project all day long.

3) Had you been studying for hours before the exam?

Pos: You had been studying for hours before the exam.

Neg: You had not been studying for hours before the exam.

4) Had he been playing soccer since morning?

Pos: He had been playing soccer since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing soccer since morning.

5) Had we been traveling for hours before reaching the destination?

Pos: We had been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.
