4) It had been raining heavily all day.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all day.

5) I had been waiting for the bus for over an hour.

Neg: I had not been waiting for the bus for over an hour.

6) You had been studying English all morning.

Neg: You had not been studying English all morning.

7) He had been working in the garden since early morning.

Neg: He had not been working in the garden since early morning.

8) She had been cooking dinner for the party all day long.

Neg: She had not been cooking dinner for the party all day long.

9) We had been driving for hours before we reached our destination.

Neg: We had not been driving for hours before we reached our destination.

10) They had been playing football for the entire afternoon.

Neg: They had not been playing football for the entire afternoon.
