### **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

**1)** Sarah will have been working on her novel for months before she submits it to the publisher.

**Neg:** Sarah will not have been working on her novel for months before she submits it to the publisher.

**2)** The workers will have been constructing the building for a year when it is finally completed.

**Neg:** The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year when it is finally completed.

---

**3)** You will have been working on the project all day.

**Neg:** You will not have been working on the project all day.

---

**4)** He will have been practicing the piano for a month.

**Neg:** He will not have been practicing the piano for a month.

---

**5)** She will have been writing the book for several years.

**Neg:** She will not have been writing the book for several years.

---

**6)** We will have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

**Neg:** We will not have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

---

**7)** They will have been playing soccer since morning.

**Neg:** They will not have been playing soccer since morning.

---

**8)** It will have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

**Neg:** It will not have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

---

**9)** John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

**Neg:** John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

---

**10)** Sarah will have been studying abroad for six months.

**Neg:** Sarah will not have been studying abroad for six months.

---
