

Exercise -Past Perfect Tense (Key)

1) Had they traveled to Europe before the pandemic?

Pos: They had traveled to Europe before the pandemic.

Neg: They had not traveled to Europe before the pandemic.

2) Had it stopped raining before we went outside?

Pos: It had stopped raining before we went outside.

Neg: It had not stopped raining before we went outside.

3) Had John read the book before watching the movie?

Pos: John had read the book before watching the movie.

Neg: John had not read the book before watching the movie.

4) Had Sarah finished her presentation before the meeting?

Pos: Sarah had finished her presentation before the meeting.

Neg: Sarah had not finished her presentation before the meeting.

5) Had the train departed by the time we reached the station?

Pos: The train had departed by the time we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not departed by the time we reached the station.
