36) Pos. We have been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Neg. We have not been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Que. Have we been traveling around Europe for weeks?

37) Pos. They have been talking on the phone for hours.

Neg. They have not been talking on the phone for hours.

Que. Have they been talking on the phone for hours?

38) Pos. It has been snowing since early morning.

Neg. It has not been snowing since early morning.

Que. Has it been snowing since early morning?

39) Pos. Mary has been playing tennis for years.

Neg. Mary has not been playing tennis for years.

Que. Has Mary been playing tennis for years?

40) Pos. The students have been studying English grammar lately.

Neg. The students have not been studying English grammar lately.

Que. Have the students been studying English grammar lately?
