36) Pos. They had been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Neg. They had not been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Que. Had they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?

37) Pos. It had been raining since yesterday.

Neg. It had not been raining since yesterday.

Que. Had it been raining since yesterday?

38) Pos. John had been studying for the exam all week.

Neg. John had not been studying for the exam all week.

Que. Had John been studying for the exam all week?

39) Pos. Sarah had been working on her art project all day.

Neg. Sarah had not been working on her art project all day.

Que. Had Sarah been working on her art project all day?

40) Pos. The children had been playing outside for hours.

Neg. The children had not been playing outside for hours.

Que. Had the children been playing outside for hours?
