Neg: We have not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

Que: Have we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?

2) I have been practicing yoga for the past month.

Neg: I have not been practicing yoga for the past month.

Que: Have I been practicing yoga for the past month?

3) You have been studying French all evening.

Neg: You have not been studying French all evening.

Que: Have you been studying French all evening?

4) He has been working on his novel since last year.

Neg: He has not been working on his novel since last year.

Que: Has he been working on his novel since last year?

5) She has been gardening for hours.

Neg: She has not been gardening for hours.

Que: Has she been gardening for hours?
