

## Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

**1)** Had it been raining heavily all day long?

**Pos:** It had been raining heavily all day long.

---

**Neg:** It had not been raining heavily all day long.

---

**2)** Had John been studying for the exam all night?

**Pos:** John had been studying for the exam all night.

---

**Neg:** John had not been studying for the exam all night.

---

**3)** Had Sarah been writing her novel for months before completing it?

**Pos:** Sarah had been writing her novel for months before completing it.

---

**Neg:** Sarah had not been writing her novel for months before completing it.

---

**4)** Had the construction workers been building the house for weeks before it was finished?

**Pos:** The construction workers had been building the house for weeks before it was finished.

---

**Neg:** The construction workers had not been building the house for weeks before it was finished.

---

**5)** Had I been waiting for the bus for two hours?

**Pos:** I had been waiting for the bus for two hours.

---

**Neg:** I had not been waiting for the bus for two hours.
