

## Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) Had it been raining heavily all day long?

Pos: It had been raining heavily all day long.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all day long.

2) Had John been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: John had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: John had not been studying for the exam all night.

3) Had Sarah been writing her novel for months before completing it?

Pos: Sarah had been writing her novel for months before completing it.

Neg: Sarah had not been writing her novel for months before completing it.

4) Had the construction workers been building the house for weeks before it was finished?

Pos: The construction workers had been building the house for weeks before it was finished.

Neg: The construction workers had not been building the house for weeks before it was finished.

5) Had I been waiting for the bus for two hours?

Pos: I had been waiting for the bus for two hours.

Neg: I had not been waiting for the bus for two hours.
