1) You have been studying English for hours.

Que: *Have you been studying English for hours?*

2) He has been playing video games all day.

Que: *Has he been playing video games all day?*

3) She has been practicing yoga since morning.

Que: *Has she been practicing yoga since morning?*

4) They have been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Que: *Have they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?*

5) John has been studying for the exam all week.

Que: *Has John been studying for the exam all week?*

6) Sarah has been working on her art project all day.

Que: *Has Sarah been working on her art project all day?*

7) The children have been playing outside for hours.

Que: *Have the children been playing outside for hours?*

8) He has been working on his car all day.

Que: *Has he been working on his car all day?*

9) She has been baking cookies since this morning.

Que: *Has she been baking cookies since this morning?*

10) Tom has been working on his novel all weekend.

Que: *Has Tom been working on his novel all weekend?*
