Pos: The dog is wagging its tail.

Neg: The dog is not wagging its tail.

Pos: The children are playing with toys.

Neg: The children are not playing with toys.

4) Are my friends coming over for dinner?

Pos: My friends are coming over for dinner.

Neg: My friends are not coming over for dinner.

5) Are the workers repairing the road?

Pos: The workers are repairing the road.

Neg: The workers are not repairing the road.
