

Exercise -Present Continuous Tense (Key)

1) They are eating lunch together.

Neg: They are not eating lunch together.

Que: Are they eating lunch together?

2) The dog is wagging its tail.

Neg: The dog is not wagging its tail.

Que: Is the dog wagging its tail?

3) The children are playing with toys.

Neg: The children are not playing with toys.

Que: Are the children playing with toys?

4) My friends are coming over for dinner.

Neg: My friends are not coming over for dinner.

Que: Are my friends coming over for dinner?

5) The workers are repairing the road.

Neg: The workers are not repairing the road.

Que: Are the workers repairing the road?
