

Exercise -Past Continuous Tense (Key)

1) The dog was chasing its tail.

Neg: The dog wasn't chasing its tail.

Que: Was the dog chasing its tail?

2) The children were laughing.

Neg: The children weren't laughing.

Que: Were the children laughing?

3) My parents were taking a walk.

Neg: My parents weren't taking a walk.

Que: Were my parents taking a walk?

4) We were having a picnic.

Neg: We weren't having a picnic.

Que: Were we having a picnic?

5) You were playing the guitar.

Neg: You weren't playing the guitar.

Que: Were you playing the guitar?
