Pos: *Were the birds singing in the trees?*

2) We were not going on a road trip.

Pos: *Were we going on a road trip?*

3) You were not playing the guitar.

Pos: *Were you playing the guitar?*

4) They were not watching a football match.

Pos: *Were they watching a football match?*

5) It was not snowing heavily.

Pos: *Was it snowing heavily?*

6) The children were not playing in the park.

Pos: *Were the children playing in the park?*

7) She was not wearing a red dress.

Pos: *Was she wearing a red dress?*

8) The teacher was not explaining a difficult concept.

Pos: *Was the teacher explaining a difficult concept?*

9) It was not getting dark outside.

Pos: *Was it getting dark outside?*

10) We were not hiking in the mountains.

Pos: *Were we hiking in the mountains?*
