42) Pos. I have been practicing yoga for the past month.

Neg. I have not been practicing yoga for the past month.

Que. Have I been practicing yoga for the past month?

43) Pos. You have been studying French all evening.

Neg. You have not been studying French all evening.

Que. Have you been studying French all evening?

44) Pos. He has been working on his novel since last year.

Neg. He has not been working on his novel since last year.

Que. Has he been working on his novel since last year?

**45) Pos.** She has been gardening for hours.

Neg. She has not been gardening for hours.

Que. Has she been gardening for hours?
