Pos: She had been practicing the piano for hours.

Que: Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

4) We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Pos: We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

5) They had not been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled.

Pos: They had been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled.

Que: Had they been playing basketball for two hours before the game was canceled?
