

## Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1)	Has John been studying for the exam since morning?
Pos:	John has been studying for the exam since morning.
Neg:	John has not been studying for the exam since morning.
2)	Will John have been working as a chef for ten years?
Pos:	John will have been working as a chef for ten years.
Neg:	John will not have been working as a chef for ten years.
3)	Will she have been studying for the exam since morning?
Pos:	She will have been studying for the exam since morning.
Neg:	She will not have been studying for the exam since morning.
4)	Have you been working on this project all day?
Pos:	You have been working on this project all day.
Neg:	You have not been working on this project all day.
5)	Had he been studying for the exam all night?
Pos:	He had been studying for the exam all night.
Neg:	He had not been studying for the exam all night.
