

## Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

**1)** Has John been studying for the exam since morning?

**Pos:** John has been studying for the exam since morning.

---

**Neg:** John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

---

**2)** Will John have been working as a chef for ten years?

**Pos:** John will have been working as a chef for ten years.

---

**Neg:** John will not have been working as a chef for ten years.

---

**3)** Will she have been studying for the exam since morning?

**Pos:** She will have been studying for the exam since morning.

---

**Neg:** She will not have been studying for the exam since morning.

---

**4)** Have you been working on this project all day?

**Pos:** You have been working on this project all day.

---

**Neg:** You have not been working on this project all day.

---

**5)** Had he been studying for the exam all night?

**Pos:** He had been studying for the exam all night.

---

**Neg:** He had not been studying for the exam all night.
