

## Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

Pos: John has been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Has John been studying for the exam since morning?

2) John will not have been working as a chef for ten years.

**Pos:** John will have been working as a chef for ten years.

Que: Will John have been working as a chef for ten years?

3) She will not have been studying for the exam since morning.

Pos: She will have been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Will she have been studying for the exam since morning?

4) You have not been working on this project all day.

**Pos:** You have been working on this project all day.

Que: Have you been working on this project all day?

5) He had not been studying for the exam all night.

Pos: He had been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had he been studying for the exam all night?
