

## Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: John has been studying for the exam since morning.

Neg: John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Has John been studying for the exam since morning?

2) Pos: John will have been working as a chef for ten years.

Neg: John will not have been working as a chef for ten years.

Que: Will John have been working as a chef for ten years?

3) Pos: She will have been studying for the exam since

morning.

Neg: She will not have been studying for the exam since

morning.

Que: Will she have been studying for the exam since morning?

4) Pos: You have been working on this project all day.

Neg: You have not been working on this project all day.

Que: Have you been working on this project all day?

5) Pos: He had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: He had not been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had he been studying for the exam all night?
