- 1) John has been studying for the exam all week.
- Neg: John has not been studying for the exam all week.
- Que: Has John been studying for the exam all week?
- 2) They have completed the course.
- Neg: They have not completed the course.
- Que: Have they completed the course?
- 3) I have met interesting people.
- Neg: I have not met interesting people.
- Que: Have I met interesting people?
- 4) They are rehearsing for a play.
- Neg: They are not rehearsing for a play.
- Que: Are they rehearsing for a play?
- 5) Mary has been playing the piano for years.
- Neg: Mary has not been playing the piano for years.
- Que: Has Mary been playing the piano for years?
