1) She enjoys going for long walks.

Neg: She doesn't enjoy going for long walks.

Que: Does she enjoy going for long walks?

2) My parents traveled abroad last summer.

Neg: My parents didn't travel abroad last summer.

Que: Did your parents travel abroad last summer?

3) We watched a thrilling hockey match yesterday.

Neg: We didn't watch a thrilling hockey match yesterday.

Que: Did you watch a thrilling hockey match yesterday?

4) He plays the piano beautifully.

Neg: He doesn't play the piano beautifully.

Que: Does he play the piano beautifully?

5) I will learn a new language.

Neg: I will not learn a new language.

Que: Will I learn a new language?
