Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Will they have finished the renovation?

Neg: They will not have finished the renovation.

2) Had he bought a new car?

Neg: He had not bought a new car.

3) Had the train departed by the time we reached the station?

Neg: The train had not departed by the time we reached the station.

4) Had the train left the station?

Neg: The train had not left the station.

5) Has she finished her work?

Neg: She has not finished her work.

6) Had you already seen that movie before?

Neg: You had not already seen that movie before.

7) Has it been a great day?

Neg: It has not been a great day.

8) Will it have been a successful venture?

Neg: It will not have been a successful venture.

9) Had they finished their homework?

Neg: They had not finished their homework.

10) Had Sarah finished her presentation before the meeting?

Neg: Sarah had not finished her presentation before the meeting.
